Løvaasen has received awards from Malmö and Ystad Art Museums (SE). Recent activity includes Greenlight Triennial (NO); solo shows at Kunsthall Grenland, Porsgrunn (NO), Belenius, Stockholm (SE) and is represented in the collections of the Public Art Agency Sweden and Gävleborg County (SE). Løvaasen has previously shown at LNM, Oslo (NO); Kunstnernes Hus, Oslo (NO); Malmö Art Museum (SE); Liljevalchs, Stockholm (SE) and Prague Quadrennial (CZ).
